Pursuant to O.C.G.A. §15-11-283, you may lose all rights to the child(ren) named in the petition brought pursuant to this article and will not be entitled to object to the termination of his rights to such child(ren) unless, pursuant to O.C.G.A. §19-7-22 and within thirty (30) days of receipt of this notice, you file;

A petition to legitimate such child(ren); and
