There shall be a presumption that by clear and convincing evidence that: (1) The parents have unjustifiably failed to comply with a previously ordered plan designed to reunite the family; (2) A child has been removed from the home on at least two previous occasions and reunification services were made available on these occasions; or (3) Any of the grounds for terminating parental rights exist, as set forth in subsection (a) and (b) of O.C.G.A. §15-11-310.
