In conclusion, the Grand Jury would like to make the below recommendations for Gwinnett County to consider.

RECOMMENDATIONS

- The Grand Jury term of 6 months is challenging. Suggest a period of 3 - 4 months. • Cell phones should be required to be turned off and put away during case presentations. Many jurors set their phones out. Perhaps allow the foreperson or clerk to monitor that. • The trip to the county jail was very informative. A possible recommendation is to have at risk youths attend session(s) as a Scared Straight program.

We noticed a monitor in the main waiting area of the county jail displaying pictures of at large criminals. Perhaps the county could have a public access channel that features wanted criminals, offering a reward for tips leading to their arrest.

Compensation - \$30.00 per session is a low amount of compensation considering the time commitment required by the Grand Jury members (6 months). There has not been an increase in jury duty pay in over 20 years, and jury duty pay is taxable income on the Juror's annual federal tax returns. Therefore, we recommend the Grand Jury compensation be increased to \$50 per session, the maximum allowed in the state of Georgia.

We recommend a very short document (3-4 pages) that would act as a quick reference guide and would assist the Grand Jurors in learning the law and the terminology that is used throughout their Grand Jury service. The document would contain the following: Definitions of the most common crimes presented to the Grand Jurors would be helpful for the first few sessions of the Grand Jury. For example: Assault, Aggravated Assault, Battery, Malice Murder, Felony Murder, Child to Children and the 3 degrees, Family Violence, Obstruction of an Office, Felony Obstruction to name just a few.

A listing of the acronyms used by the police officers and investigators. For example: LPR, G/D, NIK, TPO

A listing of the legal limits of alcohol and drugs would be helpful. For example: Legal alcohol limit while driving, the amount of a drug that is considered personal use.
