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ORDER

On July 24, 2014, Jolly M. Zeunges filed a Motion to Verify Pages are Missing, which this Court construes as a Motion for Declaratory Judgment, asking the Court to verify that pages are missing from the Inferior Court Minutes (Ordinary Purposes) 1819 – 1861 of Gwinnett County. In her Motion, Ms. Zeunges states that she is looking for information regarding David Andrews and Elsberry Andrews. Ms. Zeunges claims that pages 126 and 130 of the Minutes are missing or are the incorrect pages for information on David Andrews. Ms. Zeunges asks the Court to provide her with proof that pages 126 and 130 are missing from the Minutes.

Upon review of the Inferior Court Minutes (Ordinary Purposes) 1819 – 1861 of Gwinnett County, the Index states that information on David Andrews appears on pages 73, 111, and 112 of the Minutes; information on J.W. Andrews appears on pages 126 and 130; and information on Lively J. Andrews appears on pages 111 and 112. Page 73 states that David Andrews obtained Letters of Administration for the Estate of James Cochran on July 20, 1838. Pages 111 and 112 reference Lively J. Andrews and the estate of David Andrews in 1848. Page 126 lists election results and the number of votes received by candidate J.W. Andrews. Page 130 is a "Copy of the Acts of the Legislature 1882 – 1883" and references J.W. Andrews, J.P. 405.


In the Nineteenth Century, the Inferior/Ordinary/Probate/Orphan's Court recorded items and records regarding elections, legislative matters, and the non-probate of wills as a regular course of business. Therefore, this Court cannot find that pages 126 and 130 of the Inferior Court Minutes (Ordinary Purposes) 1819 – 1861 of Gwinnett County are missing. The pages do appear to be chronologically out of place. Pages 126 through 130 provide election information for the years 1882, 1883, and 1884 and do not show any information about Estates or

Administrations between 1819 and 1861. Based upon the foregoing, the Court finds as follows,

Pages 126 to 130 of the Inferior Court Minutes (Ordinary Purposes) 1819 – 1861 of Gwinnett County contain election information for the years 1882 to 1884 and do reference J.W. Andrews. These pages do not contain any Estate or Administration information for any decedent's estate between the years 1819 and 1861.

IT IS ORDERED that a copy of this Order shall be kept in the Inferior Court Minutes (Ordinary Purposes) 1819 – 1861 of Gwinnett County and that a deputy clerk of this Court shall cause a copy of this Order to be served by first class mail upon the Petitioner.



ORDER

On July 24, 2014, Jolly M. Zeunges filed a Motion to Verify Pages are Missing, which this Court construes as a Motion for Declaratory Judgment, asking the Court to verify that pages are missing from the Inferior Court Minutes (Ordinary Purposes) 1819 – 1861 of Gwinnett County. In her Motion, Ms. Zeunges states that she is looking for information regarding David Andrews and Elsberry Andrews. Ms. Zeunges claims that pages 126 and 130 of the Minutes are missing or are the incorrect pages for information on David Andrews. Ms. Zeunges asks the Court to provide her with proof that pages 126 and 130 are missing from the Minutes.


Upon review of the Inferior Court Minutes (Ordinary Purposes) 1819 – 1861 of Gwinnett County, the Index states that information on David Andrews appears on pages 73, 111, and 112 of the Minutes; information on J.W. Andrews appears on pages 126 and 130; and information on Lively J. Andrews appears on pages 111 and 112. Page 73 states that David Andrews obtained Letters of Administration for the Estate of James Cochran on July 20, 1838. Pages 111 and 112 reference Lively J. Andrews and the estate of David Andrews in 1848. Page 126 lists election results and the number of votes received by candidate J.W. Andrews. Page 130 is a "Copy of the Acts of the Legislature 1882 – 1883" and references J.W. Andrews, J.P. 405.

In the Nineteenth Century, the Inferior/Ordinary/Probate/Orphan's Court recorded items and records regarding elections, legislative matters, and the non-probate of wills as a regular course of business. Therefore, this Court cannot find that pages 126 and 130 of the Inferior Court Minutes (Ordinary Purposes) 1819 – 1861 of Gwinnett County are missing. The pages do appear to be chronologically out of place. Pages 126 through 130 provide election information for the years 1882, 1883, and 1884 and do not show any information about Estates or


Administrations between 1819 and 1861. 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
